IFSP supported **Community Projects** address the rehabilitation of the overall village infrastructure and the agricultural production base. Community contribute directly to improving the overall living conditions in the village. Once established, community projects are assets for the whole village. Community projects include

- Rehabilitation and development of minor irrigation schemes / minor tanks
- Rehabilitation and development of irrigation structures
- Rehabilitation and development of water supply schemes (common wells and agro-wells)
- Development of pre-schools, schools and community centres, service centres and rural market places
- Development of agri-business, e.g. seed cleaning and sorting centre
- Rehabilitation and development of rural roads and related structures and storm water drainage systems

Agricultural production based community project directly improve the availability of and the access to food. They are expected to contribute to market integration and overall stability. During participatory needs assessments (**PNA**), interdisciplinary PNA teams facilitate the analysis of common problems by the village communities and support them in identifying appropriate priority projects to overcome some of the causes of conflict affectedness, lack of social facilities and food deficit in particular. Community projects are implemented through local **Community Based Organisations** (RDS, SDS, FO) and supported by **Service Providers** (Departments and / or NGOs).

Project packages serve as a **guideline** for PNA teams during PNA for discussing the frame conditions of proposed community projects with beneficiaries. The package guidelines are the basis for the formulation of **project plans** to be elaborated by service providers and to be forwarded to the **IFSP management** for final approval.
