Project	Toilets for selected families in Allai Nagar
Basic description	Water sealed toilets for approx. 35 families as first phase of a sanitation improvement programme
Objective	Improve personal and public hygiene, reduce diseases
Participating families (min. 8 to 10; max. 30; few will result in higher costs and may create grievances amongst non-beneficiaries; too many require additional support / mobilisation)	Selection according to vulnerability criteria in open / public discussion; Commitment to actively contribute; Commitment to properly maintain toilets Commitment to improve garbage situation
Contribution of village community / Action Group or CBO (rough description)	Minimum 30% in form of labour and material according to detailed project description, BOQ; Mainly digging of pit, helping mason to construct foundations and walls etc.
Responsibilities: CBO as implementing partner Service Provider (Dept., NGO) Support Partner (DS) IFSP	Mosque Trust Committee: implementation / construction of pre-school according to IFSP standards; responsible to IFSP according to the agreement conducted; maintaining project book incl. accounts etc. in a transparent manner n.a. DS supervises work occasionally and contributes to conflict solving among CBO members Funding, technical supervision, community mobilisation; maintenance plan

Particular aspects to be addressed / considered	Willingness to contribute shall determine continuation of sanitation programme
Risk and uncertainty	May be quite high due to overall poor standard of personal and public hygiene
Overall feasibility of project	Should be ok since families expect direct benefit (individual capital asset)
